Mark 3:20-35

The holy gospel according to Mark. **Glory to you, O Lord.**

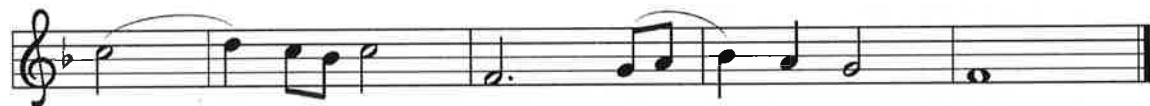
